School-Based Programmes for Primary Pupils

Complex Needs/Inclusion Programme (2-3 weeks)

> First places given to pupils with complex needs and the remainder to be allocated to pupils at greatest risk of educational disadvantage

- > Groups of up to 12 supported by 1 teacher and 1 SNA
- > Number of groups based on enrolment



Special Class and Special School Programme (2-5 weeks)

> For pupils enrolled in special classes and special schools

> Staffing resources are the same as those provided for the participating pupils during the school year

DEIS Primary School Numeracy and Literacy camps

- > Schools can choose to run up to 2 literacy and numeracy camps/Campaí Samhraidh of one weeks duration each
- > Up to 36 pupils per week each week
- > Camps supported by 1 teacher for every 12 pupils



Transport

School transport services may be available to pupils who avail of services under the SEN transport scheme. Where services are not available for pupils who normally avail of SEN transport scheme, grant funding is payable to parents following completion of programme.
